We the Washington State Board for Community and Technical Colleges and the 37 chancellors and presidents of the system respectfully request that you continue the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program for students in our system and across the country. In our state we have thousands of DACA students pursuing their dream of higher education. These current students and thousands of earlier students are attempting to better their lives and those of their families by gaining a higher education. They have and will continue to contribute greatly to our local economy and that of these United States.

DACA students must have been brought to this country as minors, stayed out of trouble, and continued to pursue an education. These students are the children of undocumented immigrants but, through no fault of their own, are not considered citizens. Many do not remember their homeland, have never returned and may never have used the language of their parents' home country. Some are student body presidents and leaders in our colleges. Many are the best students in their class. They are model students and have never been seen as a threat. On their own initiative they came forward to become part of the DACA program in our state.

Moreover, as taxpayers, we consider the enormous investment in their K-12 educations. There is no return on investment if we prevent them from entering or staying in our workforce. Many employers need bilingual and bicultural employees to help them compete globally.

These students are some of the best of the best and we fervently hope they will be able to follow their dream of higher education without the anxiety or dread that the federal authorities may interrupt their studies.

Speaking for these thousands of DACA students in our state, we respectfully appeal to you to allow them to continue their education here in Washington state and reassure them of their worth as important and vital residents of this great country.
