Operating Budget Estimate

If the system’s operating budget request of \$189 million is fully funded, Community Colleges of Spokane would receive approximately \$15.1 million in additional funding.

Capital Budget Estimate

If the system’s capital request for \$627 million is fully funded Spokane Community College will receive approximately \$6 million for maintenance, repairs and minor improvements of its existing facilities and approximately \$3.2 million for design of the Apprenticeship Center project plus a portion of the district allocation of approximately \$2.2 million for routine facility operation.
