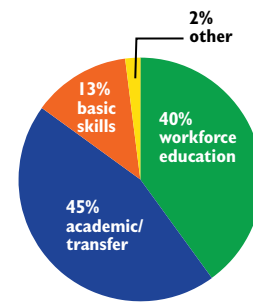

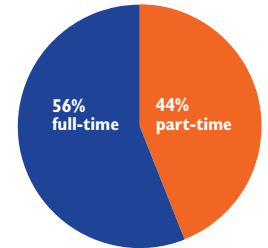

Training a Global Workforce

Green River College ensures that students graduate with the relevant knowledge needed for their fields, as well as the skills to become a successful members of our global workforce. Unique and Innovative Programs

Green River College is a major transfer institution in the state of Washington enabling students from our local communities to earn college credits that will transfer to a four-year program, at a fraction of the price of a university.

Green River College also offers five Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) degrees to prepare students for high-paying, high-growth careers: IT — Software Development, IT — Network Administration and Security, Marketing & Entrepreneurship, Aeronautical Science, and Forest Resource Management.

Sustaining Students with Support Programs

Green River provides specialized services to help all students succeed. The Commencement Achievement Program and Outreach and Service-Learning Center integrate instruction and community service to enrich learning, civic responsibility and community connections. Over 50 diverse student organizations offer roughly 150 co-curricular events to help students engage, persist and complete.
