SBCTC State Board Report

- New Executive Director – Jan Yoshiwara
- Legislative Bills to Watch
 - 5100
 - Not the sole responsibility of the FA office all of SS should be involved
 - State board asked for money
 - received \$180k already in our allocation from SBCTC
 - Can be broadly used
 - Money has been earmarked, can only be used for this purpose
 - Vendors here to help assist
 - Cascadia has a Power point that hits most of the points, not all
 - SALT no longer providing Default services
 - 5022
 - SBCTC given \$100k to develop a template for us to use
 - July 2018 implementation
 - 2037

CTC Link

- Campus Solutions been having major issues
- Pilot schools still not closed out for 15/16 or 16/17
- 9.0 version support ends 12/31/2018
- 9.2 new version
- SBCTC will move Jan 2019
 - Pilots & SBCTC will have 9.2 & have to learn
 - Oct 2019 go live (9.2)
 - +1 new college
- Oct 2019 plan is -> every 6 months a batch of college will go live (Oct & Feb)
- Q: What is the level of support these new colleges will have?
 - **A: SBCTC will have to up support personnel as most college come on**

- Q: Wasn't the plan to hire 2 teams for implementation?
 - A: **Yes they have been on the project side**
- Q: In Nov -> is it changing?
 - A: **Not sure, but thinks it is still ongoing**

WSAC

(Carissa's replacement)
- Chance to realign business processes
- Residency does not need to be re-determined every year

DACA

- 9/5/17 Administration received DACA
 - Some Students no real impacts
 - Others will have large impact
 - 1079 makes this ok? Not really but in WA makes the impact a lot less for students
 - Residency can be determined once @ the time college determine residency & if DACA has not expired the res. Determination is the same
 - More & more students will have expired DACA; then it goes to 1079
 - How do we explain this to students? Messaging
- Transfer Students colleges can use residency determinations from other schools: is it permitted
- Q: New students with valid documentation, even though DACA is rescinded, we can determine WA res?
 - A: **As long as it is not expired yes. For brand new or for transfer students is not expired or accept other college's residency status**
- Q: Can expired DACA students still do WAFSA & be eligible?
 - A: **Going to change the verbiage so that it would not be a DACA flag**
- WSAC is requesting legislation that would have DACA – like parameters in WA but no info on that
- Q: CBS is still available for students even with an expired DACA date?
 - A: **If residency was determined as an eligible, not expired DACA – Yes**
- Q: SWS similar to CBS
 - A: **Res. Not defined the same, it is more broad. They can work until DACA expires. That is an employer thing to track!**

WASFA

- Delay in opening 18*19 application – is open now
- Colleges will be able to see 18/19 in the portal this week

- WASFA Promotions going to 17/18 applicants to fill out 18*19. Also promoting through High School and social media

Financial Literacy (SB5100) – ALL NEW INCOMING STUDENTS

- Reasonable steps
 - Encouraged in orientation & as early as possible in the school year
- Last leg. Session there was a lot of discussion about loans and borrowing. Expect to see more...
 - *What should we be doing as a state?*
- No role for WSAC to be involved. WSAC is meeting other financial literacy regulations through ready set grad & through the opportunity pathways. WSAC will not assist with getting ready set grad as part of the solution WSAC doing an evaluation to see if changing ready set grad to more of a curriculum to help meet this requirement.
 - *What is ready set grad ready to provide students? - Section 1B-G -> on ready set grad but not packaged as curriculum. (in there minimally)*
