Good afternoon, cELC members:

At the last cELC meeting there was a request for a more in depth discussion about the ctcLink PeopleSoft Functional/Business Analyst role, so it is on the agenda for Thursday's meeting.

To add to the discussion, we have polled colleges and asked which colleges have one or more dedicated Business Analysts (or plan to) and if there are colleges that have no plans to hire/fill these roles. Responses are due by Noon tomorrow (11/18) and will be compiled in the meeting presentation deck, which I will send out tomorrow afternoon.

As background, this topic was originally discussed during the <u>March 21, 2019 cELC</u> <u>Meeting</u> when the ctcLink Roles and Alignment document was presented as part of a Steering Committee recommendation.

As part of its approval, the Steering Committee had requested that cELC recommend to all WACTC Presidents that the necessary roles as outlined in the document be in place at their college prior to their college's DG implementation, and sustained post-Go-Live. cELC decided not to take the recommendation to presidents and wanted to get a better picture of the SBCTC ctcLink Customer Support organization and the level of support that would be available from SBCTC in the future.
