Introduction

The Image/Upgrade Overview Document is intended to provide ctcLink users with a summary of the changes that will be made in the system as a result of the upcoming image or PeopleTools upgrade implementation. Oracle releases multiple PeopleSoft updates, called images, for each pillar every year. Each Image contains bug fixes and features that are important for PeopleSoft to work well. PeopleTools upgrades update the underlying framework of the system. There are minimal changes that are noticeable to the end users. Below is an overview of the changes that you can expect to see as part of this upgrade.

Campus Community

New Fields Added to Emergency Contacts (CS Staff) Page

The Emergency Contacts page for staff in CS includes fields such as Contact Name, Relationship, Primary Contact checkbox, "Same Address/Phone as Individual" checkboxes, and sections for Contact Address and Contact Phone. The second tab was labeled "Emergency Contact OtherPhones." Following the update, the page now includes Emergency Contact Email, Missing Person Contact Checkbox, Comments/Notes field, and the second tab label has been updated to "Other Phone Numbers." The key enhancement is the ability to designate a Missing Person Contact, email, and other notes. These changes were implemented by Oracle in response to a client's request to support Clery Act requirements for storing a confidential contact in the event a student goes missing.

Note: These updates are currently available only on staff-facing Emergency Contacts pages.

The Emergency Contact Information tab had only basic fields for name, relationship, address, and phone, with the second tab labeled Emergency Contact OtherPhones.





Image AFTER: Emergency Contacts

Student Self-Service

Address Validation for Students

Students can now select from a clickable list of suggested addresses when entering or updating their address in ctcLink Student Self Service. Previously, a static list was shown, requiring manual corrections. This change streamlines the process by allowing students to simply click on a suggested address to autofill the address fields with a validated address.

Note: These updates are currently available only on ctcLink Self-Service. HCX does not have address validation.

Before, a range of suggested addresses were displayed in a static list.





Image AFTER: Address Validation

Now, students will see Address Out of Range Suggestions displayed in a scrollable, clickable list - matching the experience staff currently have in pages like Add/Update a Person. The screenshot below shows the full range of address suggestions, including the addition of business names that may now appear in the list for students.

Stylistic Changes to Staff Pages

Oracle continues to transition PeopleSoft pages from Classic to Classic Plus styles to modernize the user experience. Classic pages tend to include a flat design and are not optimized for responsible size layouts. Whereas Classic Plus pages may be updated with newer fonts and styling. The changes only impact how a page looks; there is no effect on functionality. In most cases, the changes are very minor or even undetectable. On pages that have transitioned, users may observe slight differences in page layout, field alignment, or color variations.

Section Headers and Additional Spacing Between Fields

Some sections throughout ctcLink now include a descriptive header for that section. Additionally, you may notice some fields have more spacing between one another. An example of these changes can be found on the Term/Session Table.

Oracle has not provided a list of pages where these header and spacing changes took place, and other pages may have been similarly updated. Regardless of appearance, the functionality remains the same.

Missing section header and the Session Time Periods fields have minimal spacing between them





Image AFTER: Term Session Table > Session time Periods tab

Now, the section includes a descriptive header "Session Details" and the Session Time Period fields have additional spacing between them.



Slight Color Variations

There have been slight color variations across pages for both text and field boxes. An example of this can be found on Grade Post. Oracle has not provided a list of pages where these color changes took place, and other pages may have been similarly updated. Regardless of appearance, the functionality remains the same.

Example Navigation:

Curriculum Management > Grading > Grade Post.

No header field and the column headers are underlined rich gold color.





Image AFTER: Grade Post Run Control ID page

Now, a section header has been added, and the column text color changed to a greyish slate blue. Additionally, some drop down fields have a slight greyish tint.



Field Alignments

There have been field alignment changes to some pages. An example of this can be found on the Instructor/Advisor Table. Oracle has not provided a list of pages where these field alignment changes took place, and other pages may have been similarly updated. Regardless of appearance, the functionality remains the same.

Example Navigation:

Curriculum Management > Instructor/Advisor Information > Instructor/Advisor Table

Extra space between the "Instructor Type" and the value selecte.





Image AFTER: Instructor/Advisor Table > Approved Courses tab

CS Core Oracle Bug Infestation Tracking

When Oracle bugs related to Campus Solutions Core (CS Core) modules come to our attention, the team tracks these on our CS Core Oracle Bug Infestation Tracking spreadsheet. We update this spreadsheet with new bugs on an ongoing basis. Additionally, each Image testing cycle may resolve existing bugs (or not) or introduce new bugs. If there are any bug updates with this Image that have been discovered or existing bugs that have updated information, our goal is to incorporate these changes in our spreadsheet no later than the Image deployment date.

Bug Fix: Query FA913 Does not retrieve all students due to the message 14441, 96 does not exist


When running query FA913, Authorization Failure Report, some students were not getting selected for the report. The query used by the report selects from the STDNT_DISB_MSG table, and the rows missing on the report are identified as message set number '14441' and message number '96'. On the Disburse Aid page, when reviewing the students, the message detail page shows the edit 96 with a blank description.

The message catalog entry for Message Set number 14441, Message number 96 should have the following text:





Image: AFTER Message Detail shows correct description on Disburse Aid page





Bug Fix: Adding new budget row does not copy housing value


After a student Budget is built, if a new row is manually inserted it causes the Housing values on the Student Detail on STDNT_TERM_BDGT to disappear.

Applied PeopleCode changes to ensure that the Housing Type value will be populated accordingly when adding a new term/effective date/effective sequence row in the Student Budget Maintenance page.

Image: BEFORE Housing is blank in the Student Detail link on Student Budget Maintenance







Image: AFTER Housing value populates in the Student Detail link on Student Budget Maintenance




Image: Max and Min Pell Indicator displays on Need Summary tab of the Assign Departmental Awards page




Image: Max and Min Pell Indicator displays on the Need Summary tab of the Invoke Professional Judgement page





Image: Max and Min Pell Indicator displays on View Financial Aid Status page

Bug Fix: Error Clicking 'Copy' Button on Aggregate Aid Limit Setup Component

When clicking the 'Copy' button on the Aggregate Aid Limit setup page, an error occurs.

Applied the necessary page, record, and PeopleCode changes to ensure that no error will be encountered when using the Copy functionality of the Aggregate Aid Limit Setup page.



Bug Fix: ISIR Does not display the current effective dated row in ISIR Dataload Parms

This project contains peoplecode fix to display the latest effective dated row on the top in the ISIR Data Load Parameters Page.





Image: AFTER The most recent effective dated row shows up when opening the page



Bug Fix: SAI on some Mass Packaging and Repackaging pages display as doubled

When using plans where award period is set to "Both", the SAI that displays on status screens appear as doubled. Due to SAI value on STNDT_AWD_PER having

FED_EFC field populated on both academic and nonstandard rows.

Modified Assign process (FAPPKASN.cbl) to correctly calculate the SAI amount, used for sorting, when using a plan that has Award Period of Both.





Image: AFTER Correct SAI is displayed (these screenshots do not show the same students)





Create STDNT_AID_ATRBT_CAF Record

This image delivers a new feature on the Packaging Status Summary page. The attributes link includes a Housing Type Lock to allow users to prevent the population update to a student's Housing Type, based on certain criteria. The Housing Type Lock can be set on an individual student or in batch by using Population Selection Update. For example, students that have had their housing type field populated could have the Housing Type Lock updated to Yes in batch, so that updates cannot be made to the students Housing Type. This hyperlink appears in all aid years.


Modified the PeopleCode for the *Population Update Process* page to be saved and run without selecting values for 'Select Fields to Update' section.

In addition, the population update setup for STDNT_AID_ATRBT record can now be configured with Attributes: SFA_HOUSINGTYPE_LOCK.

Bug Fix: Future Term Pell is Incorrectly Reduced After Current Term Census

When validating a Pell item-type set up to calculate based on *Formula 1 – Full-time* until Census, and the census date has been reached for the current term, the Pell term amounts are being reduced for future terms where Enrollment Intensity (EI) is less than 100.


Note: ctcLink colleges do not have this setup so would have not faced this bug.


Image: Pell is setup to ignore Enrollment Intensity until Census Date has been reached






Images: Summer through Winter term Enrollment Intensity values (83%, 92%, 100%)
