



Human Capital Management Image 55 Supplemental Accessibility Information

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Introduction

This document is intended to supplement the Image/Upgrade Overview Document and provide ctcLink users with a more detailed summary of the accessibility changes that will be made in the system as a result of the upcoming HCM image 55. Oracle releases multiple updates every year that often include improvements to PeopleSoft's accessibility. Below is an overview of the accessibility enhancements that you can expect to see as part of HCM image 55.

Accessibility

The following bug fixes apply to users that log on to the PeopleSoft system with Screen Reader mode enabled. Screen reader mode can be enable through user preferences or the Accessibility toolbar menu on the top left of homepages.



ACCESSIBILITY FIX: DECORATIVE ELEMENT ANNOUNCED AS 'SEPARATOR' IN VETERAN STATUS.

Issue: When navigating the Veteran Status page, decorative element located above 'Your Name' and 'Today's Date' is announced to the screen reader, "Separator". Updated the Veteran status page to not announce 'Separator' element in accessibility mode. The veteran status tile can be accessed from the Self service Personal Details.

ACCESSIBILITY FIX: ENTER TIME GRID MISALIGNED USING SCREEN READER MODE

Modified code to fix the alignment issue in accessible mode for Enter Time page. In screen reader mode, input fields were misaligned.

ACCESSIBILITY: WHEN EXECUTING SEARCH, NO ALERT IS PROVIDED TO SCREEN READER USERS

Code changes made to display message to the user in screen reader mode for this page. Employee search handled differently; before, each field auto updated (type-ahead functionality), now, the pull waits for search button/icon selection. Now displays results in pop-up dialog box instead of on the page where it wasn't announced to user. Issue fixed: Context changes without notification.

ACCESSIBILITY: IN SCREEN READER MODE PERSON SELECTOR HAS AN EXTRA H2 OF STATUS MESSAGE.

Updates Person Selector to hide the message group box when it is not used, that caused an unused H2 tag on the page. Person Selector is the page that shows when entering Manager Self Service pages that you select a direct report and then enter the component. Related Information section added to page.
