

- [Navigation] Accessibility issues were addressed with the 'Skip to Main Content' link to keep user focus to the iframe content.(CATO)
- [Planner] Accessibility issues were addressed to improve the Planner checkbox labels to be more descriptive when using a screen reader.

- [Schedule] Accessibility issues were addressed to improve focus management in the calendar and list views.
- [General] Accessibility issues were addressed within CX and Schedule Builder to improve informative icons when used by a screen reader.
- [General] Accessibility issues were addressed to improve magnification when used by a screen magnifier.
- [General] Accessibility issues were addressed to improve focus management and error announcements.
- [General] Accessibility issues were addressed within Class Search and in Dashboard navigation to include improved focus indicators and tab order.
- [Evaluate My Transfer Credit] Improvements were made to address user accessibility issues.


[Schedule] Added accessibility labels to schedule filter options (SBCTC)

The 5 new filter checkbox elements on the Schedule planner, ie 'Class Exams', have no accessible name, associated <Label>, or [title].




[Springboard] Accessibility improvements to the Springboard tiles (SBCTC/CATO)

- 1. H2 Heading labels have been removed from springboard tiles
- 2. Updated semantic elements and roles that are used for springboard links




- 1. Schedule Calendar has ben refactored for keyboard accessibility
 - a. The user is able to tab through the list of calendar items and view the details for each event individually. This exception indicates that while the visual representation of the calendar is a table, accessible navigation is implemented using a different method.



High Priority Bugs Submitted by CATO & SBCTC that are in Development

Issue Reported: Button State change not announced to user

On several pages where a selection is needed to be made, (i.e. Dashboard > Edit My Widgets), the submit button is deactivated until a checkbox control, changes state (checked/unchecked). Once a selection is made, the submit button then becomes active ('Save Changes' for Widgets page)
