Image: The new columns “REPEAT CODE” and “REG DESIGNATION” are displayed on the Course List page. The Download CSV button is available on the top right corner of the page.

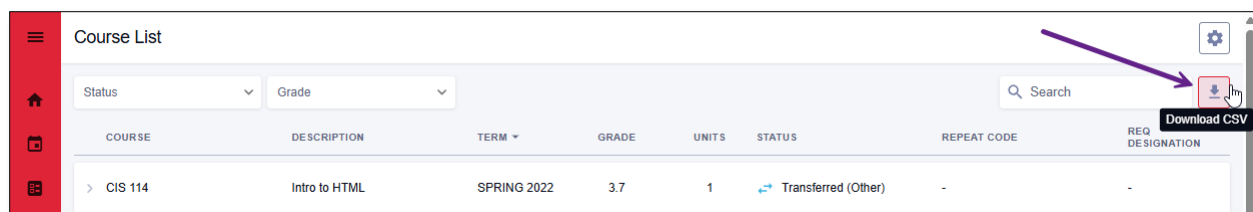
