

## BM1605 – User Batch Control Table

Required table. Codes defined by the colleges.

Use the User Batch Control Table to identify batches of cashiering transactions by logical device (for example, a cash register), cashier, or both.

### User Function Keys

<b>F1</b>	REFRESH	Redisplays the most recently saved version of the record.
<b>F2</b>	ADD	Adds a new record.
<b>F3</b>	CHANGE	Changes an existing record.
<b>F4</b>	INQUIRE	Displays an existing record.
<b>F5</b>	DELETE	Deletes an existing record.
<b>F8</b>	MENU	Returns to the FMS System Menu

### Data Fields

<a href="#">FYR</a> (display only)	<a href="#">BATCH ID</a>
<a href="#">USER ID</a>	<a href="#">STATUS</a>
<a href="#">LDEV</a>	<a href="#">RVSN DATE</a> (display only)

### Fiscal Year (FYR)

<b>Description</b>	Display only. The fiscal year of the table.
<b>Format</b>	YYYY

### User Identification Key (UK-USER-ID)

<b>Description</b>	A code identifying the person entering transactions. The User ID field is optional if LDEV information is provided.
<b>Length</b>	8 characters

### Logical Device (UK-LDEV)

<b>Description</b>	A code identifying a cashiering device (for example, a port on the HP3000). The LDEV field is optional if User ID information is provided.
<b>Length</b>	3 characters

### Batch Identifier (BTCH-ID)

<b>Description</b>	A code identifying the source or type of accounting transaction, for example, 01 (pooled cash), 02 (tuition distribution), and 10 (GL opening entries).

	Codes 01-99 are defined by SBCTC-ITD. Codes A1-ZZ are defined by the colleges.
<b>Length</b>	2 characters
<b>Edits</b>	Must be valid on the Batch Identification Table (GA1068).

### Status (EDIT-STAT)

<b>Description</b>	A code indicating the status of the key field.
<b>Length</b>	1 character
<b>Values</b>	Defined by SBCTC-ITD as follows:  <b>A</b> Active (default) <b>I</b> Inactive <b>D</b> Delete

### Revision Date (RVSN-DATE)

<b>Description</b>	Display only. A date assigned by the system indicating when the current record was changed or added.
