

## GA1035 – Major Source Table

Required table. Codes defined by SBCTC-ITD.

Use the Major Source Table to identify major source codes and corresponding titles as well as subsource indicators, due to and due from indicators, and budget levels. The major source code is an additional classification within each major group used to identify revenue sources.

For a complete list of major source codes, run the DataExpress procedure GA1035R (from Group Inform, Account PLIB).

### Fiscal Year (SV-FYR)

<b>Definition</b>	Display only. The fiscal year of the table.

### Major Group (SV-MAJGRP)

<b>Definition</b>	Key field. A code defined by SBCTC-ITD that identifies a type of revenue (for example, federal grants, miscellaneous revenues, or operating revenues).
<b>Edits</b>	Must be valid on the Major Group Table (GA1034).

### Major Source (SV-MAJSRC)

<b>Definition</b>	Key field. A code defined by SBCTC-ITD that is a further definition of a major group such as revenues from fines, capital gains or sale of property.
<b>Length</b>	2 characters

### Major Source Title (TITLE)

<b>Definition</b>	A title defined by colleges describing a major source.
<b>Length</b>	20 characters

### Subsource Indicator (SSRC-IND)

<b>Definition</b>	Entry required. A code indicating whether a subsource is required or not required.
<b>Length</b>	1 character
<b>Values</b>	Defined by SBCTC-ITD as follows:  <b>Y</b> Yes, subsource is required <b>N</b> No, subsource is not required

### Due To/From Indicator (DUE-TO-FROM-IND)

<b>Definition</b>	Entry required. A code indicating whether a due to/from fund or agency code is required or not required.
<b>Values</b>	Defined by SBCTC-ITD as follows:  <b>R</b> Due to/from fund or agency is required <b>Blank</b> Due to/from fund or agency is not required

### Major Source Budget Level (MAJSRC-BDGT-LVL)

<b>Definition</b>	Entry required. The level to which a source of revenue will be budgeted. Cannot be changed after the fiscal year begins.
<b>Values</b>	Defined by SBCTC-ITD as follows:  <b>1</b> Major source level <b>2</b> Subsource level

### Major Source Report Level (MAJSRC-RPT-LVL)

<b>Definition</b>	Entry required. The level to which a source of revenue will be reported on budget status reports.
<b>Values</b>	Defined by SBCTC-ITD as follows:  <b>1</b> Major source level <b>2</b> Subsource level

### AFRS Source of Revenue (AFRS-SRC-REV)

<b>Definition</b>	Entry required. The source of revenue code used for external reporting. This field cannot be left blank. Four asterisks (****) are assigned if it is not reported externally.

### Major Source Status (EDIT-STAT)

<b>Definition</b>	Entry required. A code indicating the status of a major source.
<b>Values</b>	Defined by SBCTC-ITD as follows:  <b>A</b> Active (default) <b>L</b> Limited <b>I</b> Inactive <b>D</b> Delete

### Revision Date (RVSN-DATE)

<b>Definition</b>	Display only. A date assigned by the system indicating when the current record was changed or added.
