Because the contractor will already be engaged, demolition would begin soon after the building permit is released. Ribbon-cutting is scheduled on May 15, 2025. UPDATE June 10,2025: Ground breaking ceremony held on May 15, 2025. Permits received and demolition of greenhouse completed and demolition of existing building started.
